IN THE THIRTY-EIGHTH YEAR OF THE REIGN OF HER MAJESTY  
QUEEN VICTORIA.

AN ACT to *Appropriate the Revenue for the period from the 1st July, 1875, to the 31st December, 1875.*

Title.

WHEREAS it is expedient to make provision for the Public Service for the period from the first day of July 1875 to the thirty-first day of December 1875

Preamble.

BE IT ENACTED by the Superintendent of the Province of Auckland with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Appropriation Act 1875."

Short Title.

2. Out of the Revenue for the Province of Auckland for the period from the first day of July 1875 to the thirty-first day of December 1875 subject to the appropriation of the Provincial Council there may be issued and applied any sum or sums of money not exceeding the sums respectively mentioned in the Schedules to this Act to defray the expenses of the several services therein specified.

Certain sums applied to specific purposes.

3. The Provincial Treasurer or other person having charge of the Public Funds of the Province shall issue and pay from time to time any sum of money not exceeding in the whole the sums respectively specified in the said Schedules to such persons and in such portions as the Superintendent for the time being shall by Warrants

Treasurer or other person in charge of Public Funds to pay money on Warrant of Superintendent.

to be granted by him from time to time direct and such Treasurer or other person having charge of the Public Funds of the Province shall in his accounts be allowed credit for all sums paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants and the receipt of the person or persons to whom such sums shall have been so paid shall be to him a full discharge of the sums for which such receipt shall have been given and the amount thereof shall be passed to his credit accordingly.

## SECOND SCHEDULE.

1. Great South and Onehunga Roads.—Any sum not exceeding the amount received in respect of the Tolls collected thereon for the period under appropriation.
2. Great North Road.—Any sum not exceeding the amount received in respect of the Tolls collected thereon for the period under appropriation.
3. Mount Eden Road.—Any sum not exceeding the amount received in respect of the Tolls and Royalty collected thereon for the period under appropriation.
4. Manukau Harbor—Any sum not exceeding the amount received from Harbor Endowments and Wharves.
