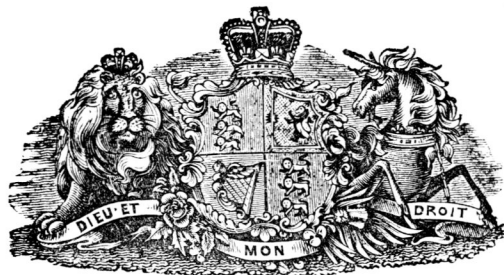

AN ACT to make further provision for the Public Service for the period ending 30th June 1875.

Title.

WHEREAS it is expedient to make further provision for the Public Service for the period ending 30th June 1875

Preamble.

BE IT ENACTED by the Superintendent of the Province of Auckland with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Appropriation Act 1875 No. 2."

Short Title.

2. Out of the Revenue of the Province of Auckland subject to the appropriation of the Provincial Council there may be issued and applied any sum or sums of money not exceeding the sums respectively mentioned in the Schedule to this Act to defray the expenses of the several services therein specified.

Certain sums applied to specific purposes.

3. The Provincial Treasurer or other person having charge of the Public Funds of the Province shall issue and pay from time to time any sum of money not exceeding in the whole the sums respectively specified in the said Schedule to such persons and in such portions as the Superintendent for the time being shall by Warrants to be granted by him from time to time direct and such Treasurer or other person having charge of the Public Funds of the Province shall

in his accounts be allowed credit for all sums paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants and the receipt of the person or persons to whom such sums shall have been so paid shall be to him a full discharge of the sums for which such receipts shall have been given and the amount thereof shall be passed to his credit accordingly.
