Short Title. 2. Nelson Trust Funds Acts to include Marlborough.
3. Section 2 of "Nelson Trust Funds Act 1854" repealed and other provisions substituted.

AN ACT to amend the "Nelson Trust Funds Title. Act 1854." [3rd December 1863.]

WHEREAS certain Acts have been passed by the General Preamble.

Assembly of New Zealand intituled "The Nelson
Trust Funds Act 1854" "The Nelson Trust Funds Amendment Act 1856" and "The Nelson Trust Funds Amendment Act 1858" applicable to the Province of Nelson as constituted at the times of the passing of the said Acts And Whereas the said Province of Nelson has since been divided into two Provinces now called respectively the Province of Nelson and the Province of Marlborough And Whereas doubts are entertained as to whether the said Acts do not apply to the Province of Nelson only as now constituted and it is desirable that such doubts should be removed

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:-

I. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Nelson Trust Short Title, Funds Act 1854 Amendment Act 1863."

II. Throughout the said recited Acts except in Section 17 in Nelson Trust Funds the "Nelson Trust Funds Act 1854" the words Province of Acts to include Marl-Nelson shall be deemed to include the Province of Marlborough and all the Provisions of the said Acts shall apply to the Territory comprised within the Provinces of Nelson and Marlborough as now constituted and shall be read and construed accordingly.

Nelson Trust Funds Amendment.

Section 2 of "Nelson Trust Funds Act 1854" repealed and other provisions substituted. III. Section 2 of the "Nelson Trust Funds Act 1854" is hereby repealed and in lieu thereof it is enacted as follows

The Governor shall from time to time by Proclamation to be published in the New Zealand Government Gazette make all necessary Provisions for the registration and revision of Lists of all persons qualified to vote at the Elections to be holden in pursuance of the Provisions of the said Act and for the appointing of Returning Officers and the conducting of such Elections and for determining of the validity thereof and otherwise for ensuring the orderly effective and impartial conduct of the same Provided always that every person heretofore elected under the said Act shall be deemed to have been duly elected and shall continue in Office accordingly.
