An Act to apply a Sum of Money out of the Con-Title. solidated Fund and other Moneys to the Service of the Year ending the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, and to appropriate the Supplies granted in this [31st October, 1876.] present Session.

OST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN,—We, Your Majesty's most Address. dutiful and loyal subjects, the House of Representatives of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, towards making good the Supply which we have cheerfully granted to Your Majesty in this Session of Parliament, have resolved to grant unto Your Majesty the sums hereinafter mentioned, and do therefore most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the General Assembly of New Zealand in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Appropriation Act, Short Title.

1876."

GRANTS OUT OF THE PUBLIC ACCOUNT.

Grant of £1,653,667 10s. 1d., and fees. 2. The Colonial Treasurer for the time being may issue out of the Public Account, and apply towards making good the Supplies granted to Her Majesty for the services of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, the several sums in the Schedule A hereto annexed, particularly mentioned, amounting in the whole to the sum of one million six hundred and fifty-three thousand six hundred and sixty-seven pounds ten shillings and one penny (£1,653,667 10s. 1d.), together with the amount of the fees hereinafter mentioned, the said moneys being inclusive of, and not in addition to, any sums issued out of the Public Account under the authority of "The Imprest Supply Act, 1876," and "The Imprest Supply Act (No. 2), 1876."

APPROPRIATION OF GRANTS.

Appropriation of £1,264,433 15s. 6d. out of Consolidated Fund, and fees.

3. (1.) All sums hereby granted out of the Consolidated Fund, amounting, as appears by the said Schedule A, to one million two hundred and sixty-four thousand four hundred and thirty-three pounds fifteen shillings and sixpence, together with the fees collected by such public officers as are authorized to retain the same in lieu of salary, are appropriated for the purposes and services expressed in the several votes in the Schedule B annexed hereto.

Appropriation of £40,000 out of Defence and Other Purposes Loan.

(2.) All sums hereby granted out of moneys raised or to be raised under the authority of "The Defence and Other Purposes Loan Act, 1870," amounting, as appears by the said Schedule A, to forty thousand pounds, are appropriated for the purposes and services expressed in the several votes in the Schedule C annexed hereto.

Appropriation of £11,904 11s. 8d. out of State Forests Account.

(3.) All sums hereby granted out of the State Forests Account, amounting, as appears by the said Schedule A, to eleven thousand nine hundred and four pounds eleven shillings and eightpence, are appropriated for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule D annexed hereto.

Appropriation of £19,963 1s. 3d. out of Confiscated Lands Account. (4.) All sums hereby granted out of the Confiscated Lands Account, amounting, as appears by the said Schedule A, to nineteen thousand nine hundred and sixty-three pounds one shilling and three-pence, are appropriated for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule E annexed hereto.

Appropriation of £304,226 1s. 8d. out of Land Fund. (5.) All sums hereby granted out of the Land Fund, amounting, as appears by the said Schedule A, to three hundred and four thousand two hundred and twenty-six pounds one shilling and eightpence, are appropriated for the purposes and services expressed in the several votes in the Schedule F annexed hereto. If the Land Fund of any provincial district shall be insufficient to meet the payments charged thereon by this or any other Act, the Colonial Treasurer may advance out of the Consolidated Fund such sums as may be necessary to make up such deficiency, and all such advances shall be repaid to the Consolidated Fund out of the first proceeds of such Land Fund.

The expenses of the Department of the Surveyor-General shall be charged upon the Land Fund arising within the several provincial districts, in proportion to the amount expended for surveys in each

district during the financial year.

(6.) All sums hereby granted out of the Trust Funds, amounting, as appears by the said Schedule A, to thirteen thousand one hundred and forty pounds, are appropriated for the purposes and services expressed in the several votes in the Schedule G annexed hereto.

Appropriation of £13,140 out of Trust Funds.

4. The expenses of the Native Land Court hereby authorized Expenses of Native Land Court charged shall, until the thirty-first day of December next, be charged against Land Court charged against provincial the several provincial districts in proportion to the time which the districts. said Court shall have sat in each such district during the six months ending on the thirty-first day of December next, and thereafter as provided by "The Financial Arrangements Act, 1876."

If the revenues accruing within any provincial district under the Native Lands Act shall be insufficient to meet the charges for the Native Land Court hereby authorized, the Colonial Treasurer may advance such sums as may be necessary up to the thirty-first day of December next to meet such deficiency, out of the moneys authorized by "The Immigration and Public Works Appropriation Act, 1876," to be applied to the purchase of Native lands within such district.

The balance of such advances found to be outstanding on the said thirty-first day of December shall be charged against the provincial district in aid of which such advances have been made; and the interest and sinking fund payable by the colony in respect of such advances shall, up to the said thirty-first day of December, be charged against such district in the manner provided by the forty-fourth section of "The Public Revenues Act, 1867," and the fifth section of "The

Public Revenues Act Amendment Act, 1871."

5. "The Payments to Provinces Act, 1872," shall remain in Apportionment of force until the thirty-first day of December next, and from and after

such day is hereby repealed.

Out of the capitation moneys payable under the provisions of the said Act up to the thirty-first day of December next, the Colonial Treasurer shall distribute and apply among the Road Boards in the several provincial districts a sum equal to five shillings in the pound on the amount of general rates received by each Board during the year ending on the thirty-first day of March last.

6. The Colonial Treasurer may issue and pay out of the Consoli-Railway Stores and Workshops Account. dated Fund any sum not exceeding in the whole the sum of thirty-five thousand pounds during the current financial year, to provide for the purchase of stores and the cost of maintaining the workshops for the working of the railways mentioned in the Schedule B hereto annexed: Provided that he shall from time to time charge the whole of the money so issued against the several railways mentioned in the said Schedule, in the proportion in which such stores and the work executed in such workshops are used upon each such railway, and provided also that each vote for the working of such railways, as set forth in Schedule B, shall not be thereby exceeded.

The Colonial Treasurer shall transfer from the Consolidated Fund Moiety of stamp to the Public Works Account one half of the moneys received up to the thirty-first day of December next, by way of stamp duties within transferred to the each province or provincial district; and the said moneys shall be Public Works issued and applied as heretofore provided by any Act in that behalf, notwithstanding the repeal of such Act by any Act passed in the pre-

sent Session of Parliament.

7. And whereas the Colonial Treasurer has, under the authority Indemnity. of the fourteenth section of "The Public Revenues Act, 1872," issued from the Public Account, during the year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six, moneys in excess of or without the appropriation of Parliament, amounting in the whole to the sum of thirty-five thousand five hundred and eighteen pounds ten shillings and elevenpence, and has applied the said sum to the several purposes and services mentioned in the Schedule H hereto annexed: Be it enacted that the application of the said sums is hereby sanctioned.

Provision for salaries in Public Trust Office. 8. And whereas by the eleventh section of "The Public Trust Office Act, 1872," it is enacted that the salary of the Public Trustee and of the other officers and servants in the Public Trust Office shall be such as shall be fixed by the General Assembly: Be it enacted that the said salaries for the year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, shall be those mentioned in Schedule I hereto annexed.

Schedules included in the Act.

9. The Schedules annexed hereto, with the notes, if any, to such Schedules, shall be deemed to be part of this Act, in the same manner as if they had been contained in the body hereof.

Advances may be made in aid of revenue.

10. In case the revenues of the Provinces of Auckland, Wellington, or Westland shall be insufficient to provide for the expenditure chargeable thereon respectively by the Appropriation Act or Ordinance in force in each of the said provinces, or by any other Act, the Colonial Treasurer may, at any time on or before the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, make advances out of the Consolidated Fund in aid of the revenues of any of the said provinces to the extent of such deficiency.

Of Auckland £44,000. Of Wellington £40,000. Of Westland £26,000. Provided that such advances shall not exceed in the whole the sum of forty-four thousand pounds in aid of the revenues of the Province of Auckland, nor forty thousand pounds in aid of the revenues of the Province of Wellington, nor twenty-six thousand pounds in aid of the revenues of the Province of Westland.

Treasury bills to the extent of £110,000 authorized.

11. For the purpose of enabling the advances authorized by the last preceding section of this Act to be made out of the Consolidated Fund, it shall be lawful for the Colonial Treasurer, from time to time, in aid or in anticipation of revenue, to cause any number of Treasury bills to be made out at the Colonial Treasury, for any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of one hundred and ten thousand pounds sterling, and the proceeds of the sale of such bills shall be paid into the Consolidated Fund. All such Treasury bills shall be prepared made out and issued under the authority of and in the manner prescribed by "The Treasury Bills Regulations Act, 1868," and may bear interest at any rate not exceeding six pounds for every one hundred pounds by the year in respect of the whole moneys contained therein: Provided always that the currency of the said bills shall in no case be made to extend beyond the first day of November, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two.
