An Acr to apply a Sum of Money out of the Public Account and other Accounts to the Service of the Year ending the Thirty-first Day of March, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-eight.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title.

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Imprest Supply Act, 1897."

£325,000 advanced on imprest towards service of year ending 31st March, 1898. 2. In addition to all sums otherwise granted, there may be issued and applied, by way of imprest, towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-eight,—

Out of the respective funds and accounts (being part of the Public Account) specified in the First Schedule hereto, any sums of money not exceeding in the whole three hundred and sixteen thousand pounds, as set forth in that Schedule; and,

Out of the respective accounts mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto, the respective sums therein set forth, not exceeding in the whole nine thousand pounds.

3. The aforesaid sums shall be charged in the manner hereafter to be expressed in any Act or Acts passed in this present session of Parliament for appropriating the public revenues of the colony for the year ending the thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-eight.
