An Act to authorise and validate certain Expenditure by Local Title. Authorities in connection with the Visit of the American [26th August, 1908. Fleet to the Port of Auckland.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Local Authorities' Indemnity Short Title. Act, 1908.

2. It shall be and be deemed to have been lawful for any local Local authorities authority to expend during the financial year ending on the thirty- authorised to first day of March, nineteen hundred and nine, and whether before expend money in connection with or after the passing of this Act, any sum or sums of money for the visit of American Fleet. purpose of taking part in the reception, welcome, or entertainment of the American Fleet or of the officers or crews thereof, at the Port of Auckland or elsewhere in the Provincial District of Auckland in that year.
