An Act to alter the Constitution of the Westport Harbour Board. 7th November, 1912.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- members, of whom four shall form a quorum.
- (2.) Of the members of the Board three shall be appointed by the Governor, two shall be elected by the electors of the County of Buller, and two shall be elected by the electors of the Borough of Westport.
- (3.) The first non-elective members of the Board shall come into office on the last Wednesday in April, nineteen hundred and thirteen, and shall hold office for three years from that date.
 - (4.) The two members to be elected by the electors of the Borough of Westport shall be elected and come into office on the day appointed for electing members of Borough Councils, and on that day a sufficient number of the members of the Board (other than those elected or appointed under this Act) shall retire from office, so that there shall not be more than seven members at any time.
 - (5.) The members of the Board in office immediately before such election shall decide which of their number shall so retire, and, in default of agreement, such decision shall be made by lot.
 - (6.) The two members to be elected by the electors of the County of Buller shall be elected and come into office on the day

(8.) The Second Schedule to the Harbours Amendment Act, 1910, is hereby amended by omitting the words "Westport Harbour Board."

(9.) Except as otherwise provided in this Act, the provisions of sections five, six, eight, nine, ten, eleven, twelve, and fourteen to twenty-six of the Harbours Amendment Act, 1910, shall be deemed to be incorporated in and to form part of this Act.

3. It shall be lawful for the Board to expend such part of its funds (not exceeding two thousand pounds in any one year) as it thinks fit in boring for coal on any part of its endowments, or on any unoccupied Crown land within the County of Buller.
