AN ACT to amend the Hospitals and Charitable Institutions Act, 1909. Title.  
[12th October, 1915.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Hospitals and Charitable Institutions Amendment Act, 1915, and shall form part of and be read together with the Hospitals and Charitable Institutions Act, 1909 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act). Short Title.

2. (1.) A Board may make to each of its members a travelling-allowance, not exceeding ~~one shilling per mile (reckoned one way only) calculated from the place of residence of the member, to cover all charges in respect of his attendance at any meeting of the Board or of any Committee thereof, or in respect of any visit of inspection to any institution when appointed by the Board or any committee thereof to make such inspection, or may pay to any such member a sum not exceeding the necessary travelling-expenses actually incurred and paid by him in respect of any meeting or visit of inspection as aforesaid.~~ Travelling-allowances.

(2.) Section thirty-two of the principal Act is hereby repealed. Repeal.

(3.) This section shall be deemed to have been in force as from the first day of April, nineteen hundred and fourteen.

3. It shall not be obligatory on the Audit Office to insist on compliance with paragraph (c) of subsection one of section eleven of the Hospitals and Charitable Institutions Amendment Act, 1913, in respect of the accounts of any Board for any financial year prior to the first day of April, nineteen hundred and sixteen.
