AN ACT to enable the Whangarei Borough Council to borrow Moneys for the Construction and Formation of Private Streets within the Borough. Title.
 [10th December, 1918.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Whangarei Borough Empowering Act, 1918. Short Title.

2. In this Act the words "private street" has the meaning attached thereto as defined in the Municipal Corporations Act, 1908. Interpretation.

3. The Whangarei Borough Council may from time to time borrow under the authority of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, any moneys it may deem necessary for the formation and construction (including footpaths, kerbing, and channelling if and where deemed necessary) of all or any of the private streets mentioned and described in the Schedule hereto, the same all being within the boundaries of the Borough of Whangarei. Empowering Council to borrow money to construct private streets.

4. For the purposes of borrowing as aforesaid the Whangarei Borough Council may make and create separate or special areas so as to include all or any of the said private streets in the said Schedule in such separate or special areas. Power to create separate areas.

5. Out of any loans from time to time raised by the said Whangarei Borough Council for the purposes aforesaid the said Council is hereby authorized to expend the moneys raised by any such loans upon the formation and construction (including footpaths, kerbing, and channelling) of any or all the private streets mentioned in the said Schedule; and the Council may impose annually upon Power to spend loan on private streets in Schedule and to levy rates.

the ratepayers, proportionately upon the unimproved value of their lands, within the separate or special area or areas created by the Council under the powers hereby given a special rate or rates in repayment to the Council of one-half of such loan or loans with interest thereon until such loan or loans is or are repaid.
