AN ACT to continue the Operation of certain Expiring Enactments. Title.
[30th August, 1919.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Expiring Laws Continuance Act, 1919. Short Title.

2. (1.) So much of the enactments mentioned in the Schedule hereto as may for the time being be unrepealed shall continue in force until the thirty-first day of August, nineteen hundred and twenty, and shall then expire unless further continued. Operation of certain expiring enactments continued.

(2.) Subsection one of section ten of the War Legislation Amendment Act, 1916, is hereby repealed. Repeal.

3. The Mortgages Extension Act, 1914 is hereby amended as follows:— Amendments of Mortgages Extension Act consequential on extension of its duration.

(a.) By omitting from the title the words "during a state of war";

(b.) By omitting from subsection one of section three the words "So long as a state of war exists in New Zealand, and for such period as may be prescribed by regulations hereunder, not exceeding six months after a state of war has ceased to exist," and substituting the words "While this Act remains in force";

(c.) By repealing subsections three and four of section three thereof; and

(d.) By omitting from subsection one of section nine the words "So long as a state of war exists in New Zealand, and for such period as may be prescribed by regulations hereunder, not exceeding six months after a state of war has ceased to exist," and substituting the words "While this Act remains in force."

4. The Expiring Laws Continuance Act, 1918, is hereby repealed.
