AN ACT to amend the Shops and Offices Act, 1908.

Title.

[22nd March, 1921.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Shops and Offices Amendment Act, 1921, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Shops and Offices Act, 1908.

Short Title.

2. (1.) Section eleven of the Shops and Offices Amendment Act, 1920, is hereby amended by adding to subsection one the following proviso:—

Section 11 of Shops and Offices Amendment Act, 1920, amended.

“Provided that a Magistrate shall have jurisdiction, on application by the occupier of any shop to which this section applies, and in which no shop-assistant other than a member of the occupier's family is employed, to exempt that shop from the operation of this section if the Magistrate is of opinion that the observance of the closing-hours fixed by this section would cause undue hardship to the occupier.”

(2.) This section shall remain in force until the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, and no longer.
