Title.

An Act to amend the Christchurch City Reserves [10th March, 1933. Act, 1877.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

Short Title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Christchurch City Reserves Amendment Act, 1932-33, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Christchurch City Reserves Act, 1877 (hereinafter referred to principal Act).

Schedule to principal Act amended.

2. The principal Act is hereby amended by omitting from the First Schedule thereto the third paragraph of the said Schedule, and by substituting therefor the following:--

"All that piece of land situate on the west side of Cathedral Square, being part of the plot of land known as the Godley Statue Block, containing by admeasurement 20.2 perches, more or less:

bounded on the north by a line running 270° 49', for a distance of 110.15 links; thence on the west by a line 179° 42', for a distance of 114.74 links; and on the south by a line 89° 58', for a distance of 111.71 links; thence on a bearing 358° 54′ 30″, for a distance of 113.13 links, to the point of commencement, which point lies from a standard stone situated in Colombo Street immediately in front of the Anglican Cathedral in a northerly direction 359° 49′ 5″, for a distance of 28.8 links; thence on a bearing 269° 49′ 5″, for a distance of 156.4 links; thence on a bearing 359° 49′ 5″, for a distance of 86.35 links; and finally on a bearing of 198° 48', for a distance of 32.33 links: as the same is delineated on the plan deposited in the Head Office, Department of Lands and Survey, at Wellington, as No. 2622, and thereon edged red."

3. The balance of the said plot known as the Godley Portion of Statue Block is hereby declared to be street. Any Godley Statue Block declared structures existing thereon at the passing of this Act to be street. are hereby declared to have been lawfully erected, but no additional structure shall be erected on such street save with the prior consent of the Minister of Lands.

4. The Christchurch City Council shall within six Council to months after the passing of this Act re-erect the statue of Godlev Statue John Robert Godley on the land described in section on old site. two hereof.
